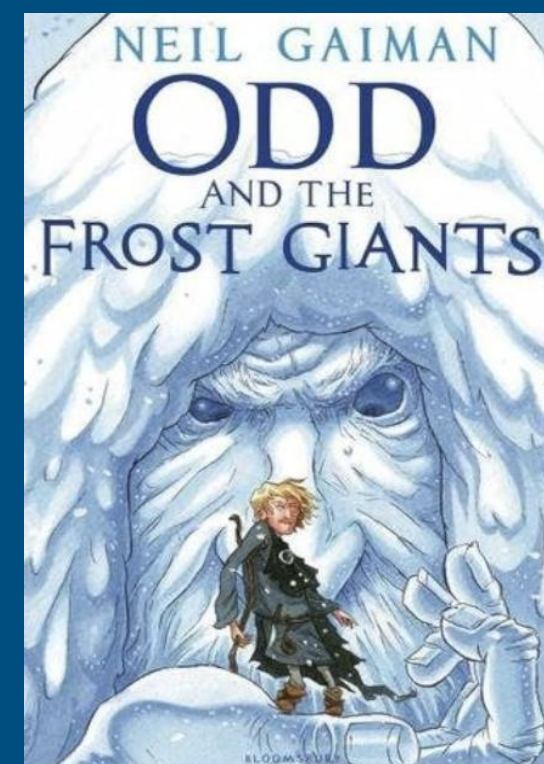
## Synopsis

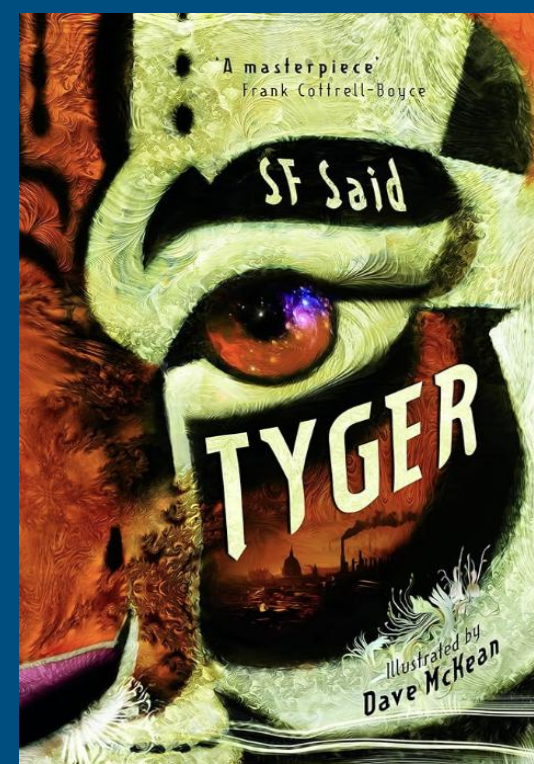
## Synopsis
