Is it a hot or a cold place?
















Different places in the world have different climates, depending where in the world they are. The globe has an imaginary line around its middle called the **equator**.

Countries near the North and South Poles are the coldest countries.



Countries near the equator are usually the hottest countries.






The wet seasons are from March to May and November to December.
