His second answer is reasonable. As 7,441 is close to 7,500, and he is subtracting 500. This will leave 7,000.

Calculation	Zach's estimated answer

Zach's first answer is not reasonable. His number would have got bigger than 4,384 because he is adding to it.

His second answer is reasonable. As 7,441 is close to 7,500, and he is subtracting 500. This will leave 7,000.
