

## MAKE YOUR OWN 3D STAR!

## You will need:

Star template (below)
Thick card
Felt tips, glitter glue and sparkles
Scissors
Colourful thread



## Your finished star should look something like this:



## How to make your 3D star:

Provide children with the star template above (see the corresponding activity in the 'Spread joy this Christmas' all-age talk). Using the template, children draw and cut out two identical stars using fairly thick card. They then make a slit halfway up both stars. After decorating their stars with felt tips, glitter glue, sparkles and whatever else you have handy, slot the two stars together to create a 3D star. The final stage is to make a hole in the top of the star and use colourful thread to create a loop to hang the decoration on a Christmas tree.
