Dear Parents,

As you will be aware, discussion has begun at parliament level about an eventual return to school. We do not expect schools to open before June 1st and it is likely any re-opening would be managed in a phased way, with specific year groups attending school on any given day/ week, the whole school will not be able to return at once in the way that we ran before closure and year groups may well be split to ensure social distancing is able to take place.

As of yet we have no clear directive on how this should take place, however please be assured that as soon as we receive further information, I will let you know. In the meantime, our teachers continue to work hard to plan and upload learning for your children to complete at home and are available for email support from 9 - 3.30 Monday - Friday.

This week we have seen a rise in parents asking for working printing at school. We are very happy to accommodate those people who are really in need of this - but I have concerns about the foot fall that this causes at school. In light of this, I have asked teachers from next week to try their hardest to plan activities that don't need sheets printing. Additionally, the government has recently announced that anyone in England showing symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) who has to leave the home to go to work, or is aged 65 and over, is eligible for testing along with members of their households with symptoms. This is in addition to all essential workers with symptoms. Testing can be booked through a new online system.
