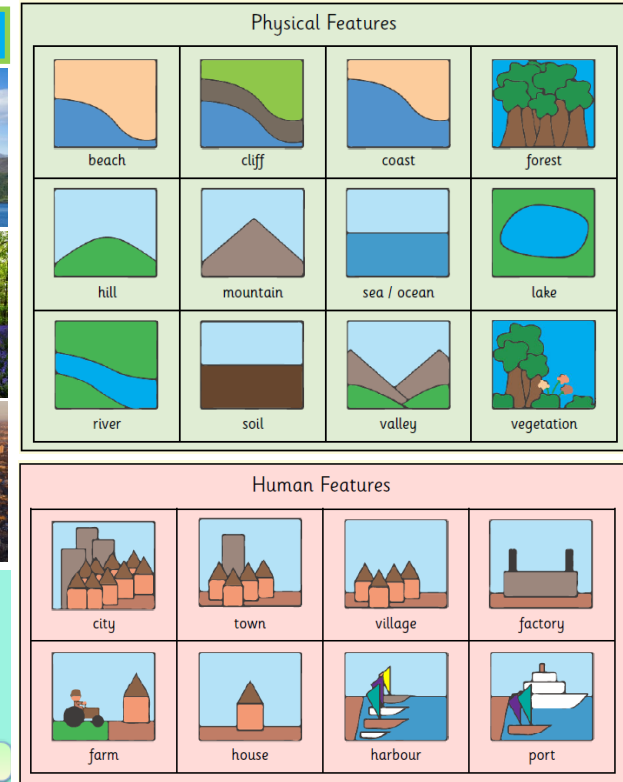
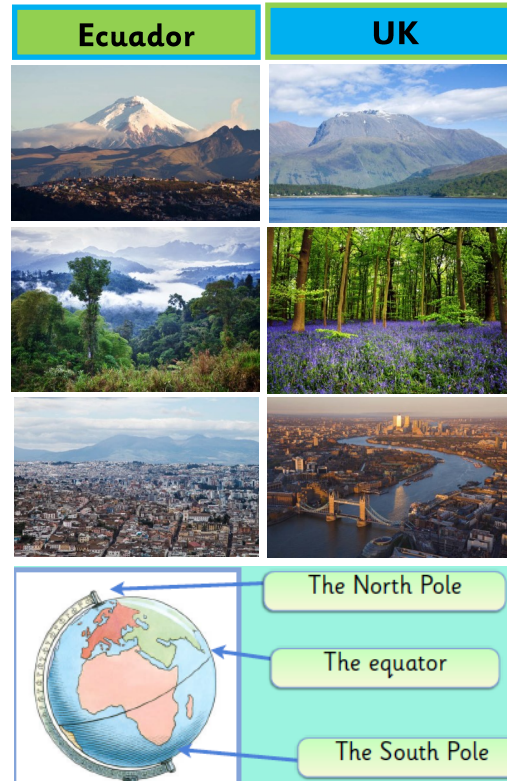


## Key skills and knowledge

## Key Vocabulary

- **Continents:** Large areas of land made up of smaller countries. There are 7 continents.
- **Oceans:** Huge bodies of salt water. There are 5 oceans.
- **Poles:** The points at the very top and bottom of Earth.
- **Equator:** Imaginary circle around the middle of Earth.
- **Physical features:** Things that appear on Earth naturally.
- **Human features:** Things that have been made by humans.
- **Landmarks:** Features or objects that make a place easy to recognise.
- **Aerial photos:** pictures taken from high above ground
