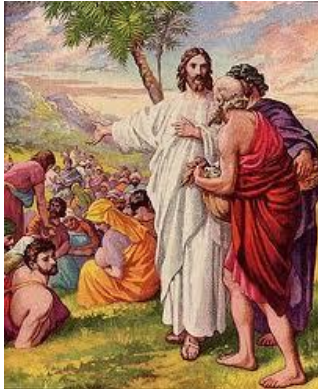


**TASK 1 - Read the story below of feeding the 5000 then complete the tasks below.**

Jesus said a prayer and started to break apart the bread and fish. His disciples handed it round the crowd. There was more

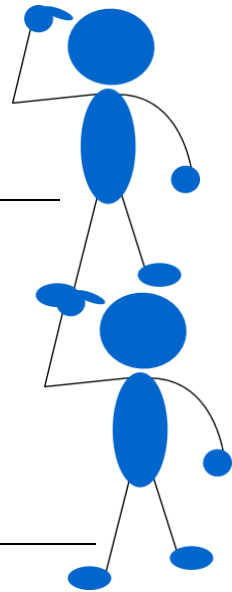
than enough for everyone - in fact, there were 12 baskets of leftover food.

What would you find easy to share, and what would be difficult to share?

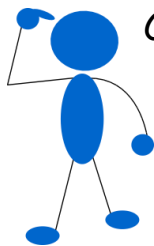
Why would it be difficult to share this?
